Loss of Insurance Coverage Eligibility



Members will be unable to use the health insurance card as of the day after retirement, or the day after they cease to be a dependent. When retiring or when no longer a dependent, return your health insurance card to your employer immediately. If you do not return your health insurance card and mistakenly use it, you will be charged for medical expenses at a later date.



Using Your Health Insurance Card

Bring your health insurance card every time you visit a medical

institution. Under the Japanese National Health Insurance system, patients pay 30% (or 20%) of the cost of medical treatment when presenting their health insurance card to a medical institution that accepts insurance. The remaining 70% (or 80%) is covered by health insurance.





Insurance.

Health insurance does not cover medical treatment due to work-related illness or injury.

This is covered by Industrial Accident Compensation

When using health insurance for medical treatment due to a **traffic accident, etc.**, be sure to submit a Notification of Injury Due to an Act by a Third Party to a branch of the Japan Health Insurance Association in your jurisdiction.





Should you **lose your health insurance card**, immediately submit an Application for Reissue of Health Insurance Card through your employer and have it reissued. In the event of damage to the card, please include the damaged health insurance card together with your application.

Any fraudulent use of the health insurance card, such as using the card when you are no longer covered or lending it to a third party, may result in imprisonment for fraud under criminal law.
